What is the S.M.A.R.T Molloy Giving Program?

S.M.A.R.T. Support our Mission of Academics, Reflection and Transformation is an online, paperless giving program which allows you to donate to Molloy College through a regular payment schedule.

Why should I choose the S.M.A.R.T. Program to make donations?

Choosing S.M.A.R.T. is a convenient way to break down your donation into small manageable payments. This helps you support the College and helps us by encouraging more donors to support Molloy.

Can the S.M.A.R.T. Program be used for capital campaign or scholarship donations?

Yes, S.M.A.R.T. Program supports all funds at the college, including the Molloy Fund, phonathon, specific scholarships and the capital campaign.

Do I have to use a credit card to join?

Yes, in order to make online donations a credit card is necessary; Mastercard, Visa, or Amex.

Is there a minimum donation?

You choose the amount that's best for you. A typical donation is a \$30 per month S.M.A.R.T. payment (about a dollar a day), which becomes \$360 a year. The minimum pledge is \$60 or \$5 per month.

Can I adjust my donation?
